Who Remote Research Clinicians support

Remote Research Clinicians project managers coordinate and operationalize in-home visits, allowing site staff to focus on more complex study responsibilities. Our qualified registered nurses are trained on study protocols, assessments, and specific requirements. Before the first visit, principal investigators and site staff receive the nurse's credentials and may request an introductory meeting.

Source documentation is provided for site review within 24–48 hours of each visit and undergoes a Good Clinical Practice

(GCP) review before finalization. By managing less complex visits, remote nurses help reduce site burden and free up staff time for higher-priority tasks.

Patients value the convenience of in-home services, reporting shorter travel and wait times, greater comfort, and a more personalized experience. These benefits contribute to improved patient participation, lower dropout rates, and enhanced diversity in clinical trials.

Remote Research Clinicians also support direct-to-patient delivery and administration of investigational products, along with data and specimen collection.
