Minimizing Protocol Deviations

Challenge: New cholesterol medication trial protocol deviation rate was higher than expected.

Insight: Scatter plot from Quintiles Infosario immediately revealed deviations were higher in only two regions, France and Montreal. Drill down into deviation types indicated a medication storage problem.

Outcome: Quick identification of root cause: failure to translate refrigeration instructions. Packaging corrections were promptly made — in days, not weeks.

Investigate Adverse Events Sooner

Challenge: Sudden climb of adverse event rates in a diabetes study.

Insight: Graph from Quintiles Infosario aggregated adverse events by type. A quick drill down into holistic patient profiles eliminated lengthy manual patient-by-patient document sorting.
